Potentate:

He shall be responsible to Shriners International for the government of the Temple.

He shall require the Temple, its officers, and members to continuously observe the Shriners International and the Isis Shrine's bylaws.

He shall appoint the non-elected Temple officers and committees.

He shall require accurate records to be kept and just accounts rendered. He shall require regular returns to Shriners International and promptly pay candidate fees, annual per capita taxes, hospital levies, and assessments.

He shall require at least one stated meeting in each calendar quarter of each year, and the first meeting of each calendar year must be held in January as required in the Shriners International bylaws and all as more fully set out therein.

He may issue orders to Nobles, clubs, units, and organizations within his jurisdiction to comply with matters over which he has authority. All such orders shall be confirmed in writing and mailed to the affected Noble or Nobles.

He shall appoint a temple attorney with the official Divan's approval. The temple attorney shall be a Noble and a bar member who is knowledgeable and experienced in the law.

He shall help with the search for the next Oriental Guide.

He shall present his budget at the first stated meeting in January.

He is encouraged to attend at least one meeting of each Unit and Club (if called) at least once throughout the year.

If he so sees, he shall determine the Potentate's Fundraiser and, with the help of the Divan, develop and implement it throughout the Temple.

If elected, he shall represent the Temple at the Central Shrine State Association (CSSA) business session, vote on all legislation, and participate in its events.

He is encouraged to attend the CSSA summer session to represent the Temple and participate in its events.

If elected, he shall attend the Shriners International Imperial Session to represent the Temple, be present for all legislation to be voted on, and participate in its events.

He shall read and familiarize himself with Shriners International and Isis Shrine bylaws.

He shall review the Isis Shrine Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) and make appropriate updates as he sees fit. These changes will be implemented, and the new SOP will be executed no later than February 1 of his year as elected Potentate.

He is encouraged to attend parades throughout the jurisdiction of the Isis Shrine.

Chief Rabban:

- He shall prepare and complete the proposed Temple budgets for the ensuing year. This budget will be prepared with the help of the finance committee and the Divan. It shall be presented at the Annual Meeting and voted on by the Nobility.
- He shall report or cause to be reported to the appropriate stated meeting of the Temple proposals for amendments to, or departures from, the budgets and the reasons.
- He will make copies of the complete budgets for the succeeding year available upon request to each member at least seven days before the meeting at which they are to be considered. The proposed budgets shall be in detail and in accordance with the Uniform Chart of Accounts prescribed by Shriners International, together with the amount budgeted for the preceding year.
- He shall assist the Potentate with his duties as he sees fit.
- If the office of Potentate becomes vacant for any reason, the Chief Rabban shall act as Potentate until a special election is held and the office thereby filled.
- He shall help with the search for the next Oriental Guide.
- He is encouraged to attend each Unit and Club (if called) meeting at least once yearly.
- He is encouraged to attend parades to represent the Temple properly.
- If elected, he shall attend the Shriners International Imperial Session to represent the Temple, be present for all legislation to be voted on, and participate in its events.
- If elected, he shall represent the Temple at the Central Shrine State Association (CSSA) business session, vote on all legislation, and participate in its events.
- He is encouraged to attend the CSSA summer session to represent the Temple and participate in its events.
- He shall promote membership, public relations, the Children's Travel Fund, and the \$100 Million Club, and act as a Masonic liaison in their endeavors during the year.
- He shall read and familiarize himself with Shriners International and Isis Shrine bylaws and the Isis Shrine SOP.
- If any elected members cannot attend the event they were elected for, he shall take that elected Nobles position if he is not already an elected member for the same event. This replacement will be at the discretion of the Potentate.

Assistant Rabban:

- He shall assist the Potentate and Chief Rabban with their duties as they see fit.
- He shall help with the search for the next Oriental Guide.
- He is encouraged to attend each Unit and Club meeting to discuss things happening around the Temple and encourage them to be more active.
- He is encouraged to attend parades to represent the Temple properly.
- He shall attend the Kosair Charities Shrine Leadership Conference (formerly Assistant Rabban Seminar) in a location determined by Shriners International.
- He shall fill in on the Ceremonial Divan during ceremonials.
- He shall start preparing for his year as Potentate. He shall help Chief Rabban with budget analysis and budget preparation. He shall begin to think of a theme, pin, uniform, and trip (if he has one).
- If elected, he shall attend the Shriners International Imperial Session to represent the Temple, be present for all legislation to be voted on, and participate in its events.
- If elected, he shall represent the Temple at the Central Shrine State Association (CSSA) business session, vote on all legislation, and participate in its events.
- He is encouraged to attend the CSSA summer session to represent the Temple and participate in its events.
- He shall promote membership, public relations, the Children's Travel Fund, and the \$100 Million Club and act as a Masonic liaison in their endeavors during the year.
- He shall read and familiarize himself with Shriners International and Isis Shrine bylaws and the Isis Shrine SOP.
- If any elected members cannot attend the event they were elected for, he shall take that elected Nobles position if he is not already an elected member for the same event. This replacement will be at the discretion of the Potentate.
- He shall work with Chief Rabban to prepare his budget for the upcoming year.

High Priest and Prophet:

He shall assist the Potentate, Chief Rabban, and Assistant Rabban with their duties as they see fit.

He shall perform all prayer for events for which he is present.

He shall be Chairman of the Membership Committee with the Oriental Guide as the Assistant Chairman.

He will work with the Oriental Guide to continuously develop a 3-year plan to increase membership.

He will make phone calls, send emails, attend Shrine Club meetings, and do whatever is necessary to increase membership.

The HP&P and OG will develop other Nobles to help with the Recruitment, Retention, Restoration, and Relationships necessary to grow membership.

He shall help with the search for the next Oriental Guide.

He is encouraged to attend each Unit and Club meeting at least once a year to discuss things happening around the Temple and encourage them to be more active.

He is encouraged to attend parades to represent the Temple properly.

He will be available to give Grave Side Services for departed Nobles.

If elected, he shall attend the Shriners International Imperial Session to represent the Temple, be present for all legislation to be voted on, and participate in its events.

If elected, he shall represent the Temple at the Central Shrine State Association (CSSA) business session, vote on all legislation, and participate in its events.

He is encouraged to attend the CSSA summer session to represent the Temple and participate in its events.

He shall promote membership, public relations, the Children's Travel Fund, and the \$100 Million Club and act as a Masonic liaison in their endeavors during the year.

He shall read and familiarize himself with Shriners International and Isis Shrine bylaws and the Isis Shrine SOP.

He shall act as Assistant Chairman of the Membership Committee with the High Priest & Prophet.

He will work with the High Priest & Prophet to continuously develop a 3-year plan to increase membership.

He will make phone calls, send emails, attend Shrine Club meetings, and do whatever is necessary to increase membership.

The HP&P and OG will develop other Nobles to help with the Recruitment, Retention, Restoration, and Relationships necessary to grow membership.

He shall help with the search for the next Oriental Guide.

He is encouraged to attend Unit and Club meetings to discuss things happening around the Temple and encourage them to be more active.

He is encouraged to attend parades to represent the Temple properly.

If elected, he shall attend the Shriners International Imperial Session to represent the Temple, be present for all legislation to be voted on, and participate in its events.

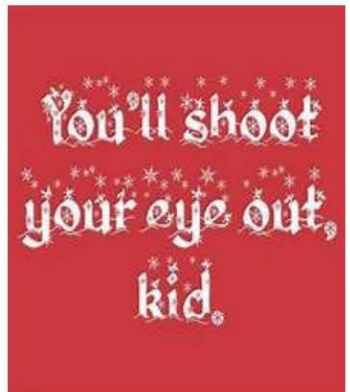

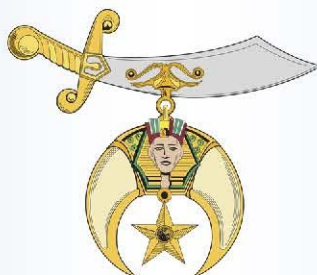

SHRINER LEGACY PROGRAM

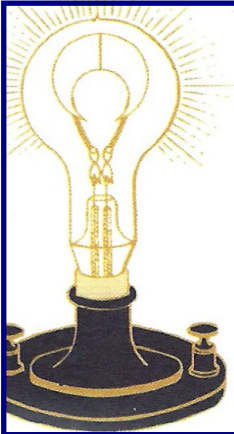

All Nobles and Ladies must follow the guidelines of Shriner International General Order #1 and Bylaws when parading. Please check the Isis Shrine website and social media for updated information on times, staging areas, and other pertinent information.

2025 Dues Delinquents

There are still 27 Nobles who have not paid their 2025 dues. Not paying their dues means that they are not allowed to vote at Club, Unit, or Temple meetings, and cannot participate in parades, or other events. This is because they are not covered by our insurance if their dues are not paid in full. If these Nobles paid their dues, over \$3700 in revenue would be generated for the Temple. If you would like to assist the Divan in contacting these Nobles about paying their 2025 dues, please contact the office and they will be able to share the list with you. If you are one of these Nobles, or know one of these Nobles, please take care of this at your earliest convenience.
